Unwell

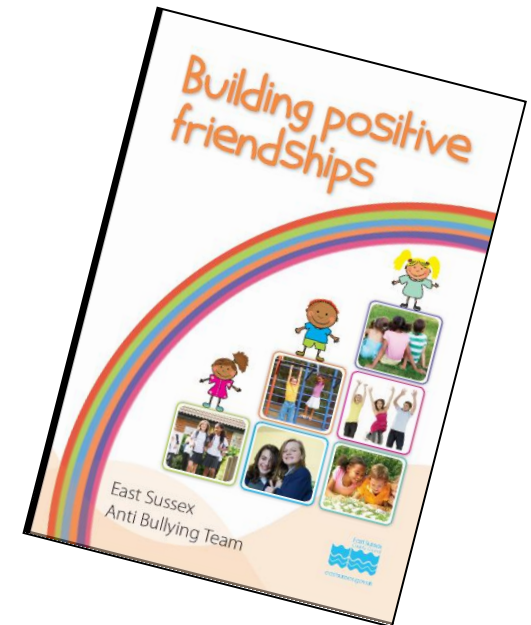


Everybody has the right to be treated with respect.
