Unwell

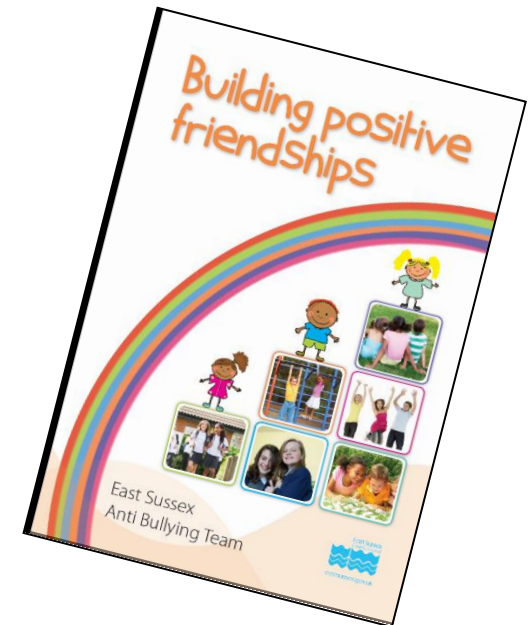


Everybody has the right to be treated with respect.

It is **Lucy's** job to help me feel safe. I can talk to her if someone is making me or another pupil feel unhappy or scared.

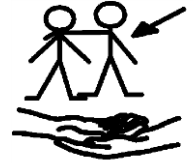
