Congratulations to our two students who performed at the Performing Arts festival in Poland for Autism Awareness Week. A wonderful achievement and you should be very proud.

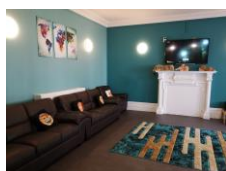


Reminder: Plastic bottle greenhouse
