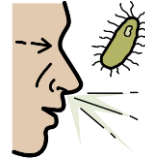


Back to school in September

Social Story



In March, the Government said that we should all stay at home to keep each other safe from a disease called Coronavirus.



The Government have now said it is safe to go back to school.



You will travel to school in a taxi.
You will need to wear a face mask.
The drivers will also wear a face mask.
This helps to keep everyone safe.



You may be travelling on your own or with a few other pupils from the different '**bubbles**' in the school. The taxi and the driver might be different to your usual one too.

When you arrive at school, you will use these entrances to go to your 'bubble'.

If you are in **Primary**, this is your entrance.



If you are in **Secondary**, this is your entrance.



If you are in **Middle**, this is your entrance.



Before you enter your classroom, you will be asked to wash your hands. It is very important to keep your hands clean.



Primary, Middle and Secondary pupils will stay in their areas of the school. These are called '**bubbles**'.

You will stay in your '**bubbles**' throughout your day at school.

If I am feeling sad, worried or angry about going back to school, I can talk to an adult.

This is ok.



If you need the toilet, please let your teacher know.

Only **2 people** can go to the toilet at a time.



We need to remember to keep to the left hand side of the corridors.

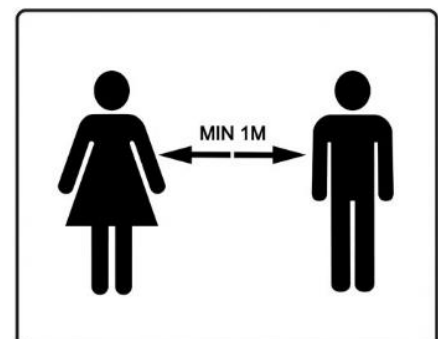
This will be easier for people to move around the school without bumping into each other.



Social distancing means that we need to keep away from each other.

Staying away from other people can help to stop the virus from spreading.

Everyone will need to keep their social distance of at least **1 metre** when you are in school and **2 metres** when you are in the community.



Primary and Middle school

You will stay in your classrooms for majority of the school day.

Secondary

To move to your different subjects/classes, you will use the doors from the outside to enter the classroom.

You will only use S1, S3 and S5 doors.

During play time and lunch time, you will only be allowed to play on one playground.

Primary will use this playground.



Middle school will use this playground.



Secondary will use this playground.



Remember to keep your social distance outside too.

There will be a timetable for when the 3 different 'bubbles' can use the Sensory Field and MUGA.



There will be an assembly for your **'bubbles'** on different days in the week.

This will be in the main hall.

You can still order snacks and lunch from Mrs Gibson in the kitchen if you would like to.

When it is lunch time, Primary and middle school will eat their lunch in their classrooms.

Secondary pupils will eat their lunch in the dining room.



You will wear your uniform to school.

There is a new uniform for Church Lawton School.



You will be asked to wash your hands, before you eat, after you have eaten and after outdoor play too.

This will help to stop any germs from spreading.



Make sure you use a tissue when you cough or sneeze. This will help to stop spread germs too.

If you feel unwell, you **need** to stay at home.

If you feel unwell in school, you **need** to let your teachers know as soon as possible.



After a good day at school, you will collect your belongings for home and wash your hands before you leave.

You will leave the same way you entered school and get on your taxi.
