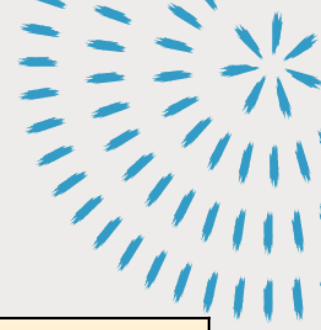


Holi is a popular ancient Hindu festival, also known as the "festival of spring", the "festival of colours", and the "festival of love".
