PREVENT DUTY REFERRAL PROTOCOL

CHURCH LAWTON SCHOOL PREVENT DUTY REFERRAL PROTOCOL

STEP 1	Staff record concerns on CPOMS as with any safeguarding concern.
STEP 2	<p>The Designated Safeguarding Lead or their Deputy will seek advice from CHECS, CHAD or SCiES and, if necessary, assess the risk further using the CSE Tool. Parents views would also be added to the document.</p> <p>(For an informal discussion you can also speak to Mark Blake, PREVENT Coordinator, Counter Terrorism Policing North West 0151 7774878)</p>
STEP 3	<p>If CSE tool highlights areas of concern, Cheshire East Consultation Team may request a PREVENT referral form be completed by DSL or DDSL: https://childrenandfamiliesportal.cheshireeast.gov.uk/web/portal/pages/childrensp-reventreferral#h1 A copy of this form will also (automatically) be sent to prevent@merseyside.pnn.police.uk</p>
STEP 4	<p>After consideration, if warranted the Local Authority pass the referral to the Channel coordinator for management through to the Local Authority Channel panel.</p> <p>The Channel panel will consider support options.</p>
